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CENTRE TAKES STRICT ACTION ON PAPER LEAK...

POISED FOR HEFTY FINES AND INCREASED JAIL TERMS?

New Delhi: Amidst nationwide student protests over the NEET paper leak controversy, the Central Government is preparing to take a significant step. It has decided to further strengthen the existing Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Act, 2024, to curb paper leaks and irregularities in examinations. Reports suggest that the Union Cabinet is likely to approve amendments to the Act this Friday.

The proposed amendments reportedly include a provision to establish special fast-track courts for adjudicating paper leak cases. Authorities are also considering increasing the jail terms and fines for the accused. Currently, those convicted in paper leak cases face imprisonment ranging from three to five years and a fine of up to ₹10 lakh. For organized crimes, the existing provisions entail imprisonment of five to ten years and a minimum fine of ₹1 crore.

Following Cabinet approval, the amendment bill is likely to be introduced in the Lok Sabha on Monday. On Thursday, Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced that stricter measures would be taken against paper leaks. He revealed that orders had already been issued to set up fast-track courts and emphasized that all necessary steps would be taken to uphold the sanctity of examinations and safeguard the students' future. Opposition leader Rahul Gandhi alleged that 150 paper leaks have occurred in the country over the past decade, yet not a single person has been convicted in any of the cases. He noted that students are demanding the resignation of Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan.

According to the government's plan, the election process will be completed first, followed by consultations with the winning union to seek their views. Subsequently, the final modalities regarding the financial, administrative, and legal aspects of the merger will be finalized. It is understood that the RTC management has already received indications from the government to be prepared for an official announcement regarding the merger on December 9. Overall, it is evident that the government is moving forward with a concrete plan to fulfill its promise and realize the dream of the RTC employees.

Good news for Telangana RTC employees... the long-cherished dream of RTC workers is set to be realized



A significant development has occurred regarding the realization of a decades-long dream held by Telangana RTC employees. The state government is actively working to fulfill the long-standing aspiration of merging the RTC workforce into the government. Reliable sources indicate that if everything proceeds according to plan, a final decision on the merger could be announced on December 9—the date associated with the announcement of Telangana's formation. Meanwhile, officials are engaged in finalizing the modalities for the merger process.

As part of the merger process, the government has decided to first conduct elections for the recognized RTC trade union. Joint Commissioner of Labour Sunitha has been appointed as the nodal officer for this purpose. These elections are likely to be held in the third week of August. Transport Minister Ponnamm Prabhakar has already clarified that the winning union will be involved in formulating the merger modalities. Encouraged by this assurance, trade unions are treating the election as a matter of prestige and have intensified their campaigns across various depots.

It is well known that RTC employees went on strike in April of this year. They had presented 32 demands to the management, including merger with the government, the conduct of trade union elections, and salary parity with government employees. The government has already fulfilled many of these demands in accordance with the assurances given at the time. Now, the focus has shifted to the crucial processes of the merger and the elections.

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CENTRE CRACKS DOWN ON OBSCENE CONTENT... ANOTHER 50 OTT APPS BANNED!

NEW DELHI:

50 OTT APPS BANNED!

The Central Government has taken another decisive step to curb obscene and objectionable content on digital platforms. It issued a significant order blocking 50 OTT apps nationwide that were broadcasting indecent visuals harmful to society. It is noteworthy that the Centre, having previously taken action against 25 apps last year and another 5 in February of this year, has now cracked down heavily on even more apps.

Dr. L. Murugan, Union Minister of State for Information and Broadcasting, disclosed this information in a written reply in the Lok Sabha. He clarified that the government continuously monitors content on digital platforms and will take strict action, without any leniency, against apps that violate the law.

ACTION UNDER STRINGENT LAWS:

Action was taken against these apps in accordance with the Information Technology (Digital Media Ethics Code) Rules, 2021. Officials found that the content on these platforms violated Section 294 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and Section 4 of the Indecent Representation of Women (Prohibition) Act. Access to these apps was completely blocked after it was determined that they were promoting obscene visuals solely to generate revenue through views and subscriptions.

Although the list of banned apps is currently being kept confidential, the Centre has ordered their immediate removal from the Google Play Store and Apple App Store to prevent users from downloading them. It also directed Internet Service Providers (ISPs) to block access to these apps. Meanwhile, the Centre issued a stern warning stating that, under the new IT rules, social media and digital platforms must remove unlawful content within just three hours of receiving a court or government order.

SHOULD ANSWER IN PARLIAMENT, NOT JUST SPEAK ON 'MANN KI BAAT': MALLIKARJUN KHARGE
