

“Big fish' of corruption caught in ACB net... Bundles of cash found at Peddapalli Municipal AE's house!”

- Peddapalli Municipal AE Kallepalli Satish Kumar Arrested
- Caught red-handed by the ACB while accepting a bribe of ₹2 lakh
- Accused of demanding a bribe to sanction a contract bill
- Over ₹32 lakh in unaccounted cash seized from the official's residence
- Officials to produce the accused before the Karimnagar ACB Court

Officials announced that the accused, Satish Kumar, has been taken into custody and will be produced before the special ACB court in Karimnagar. They stated that a case has been registered regarding the incident and an investigation is underway. The ACB urged the public to report any instances of government officials demanding bribes by calling the toll-free number 1064, assuring that the complainants' details would be kept confidential.



After catching Satish Kumar while he was accepting a bribe, ACB officials conducted searches at his residence. The officials were astonished to discover unaccounted cash amounting to ₹32,31,900 during the searches. They seized this cash along with the bribe money.

A corrupt official was caught red-handed by Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) officials during a raid in Peddapalli district on Tuesday. ACB officials laid a trap and apprehended Kallepalli Satish Kumar, an Assistant Engineer (AE) at the Peddapalli municipal office, while he was accepting a bribe of ₹2 lakh from a contractor.



ACB officials stated that Satish Kumar demanded this bribe to process and forward for sanction the final bill of ₹12.28 lakh due to a contractor for development works at the Hindu cremation grounds located at Tenuguwada and Kunaram Road in Peddapalli town. Acting on a complaint from the aggrieved party, officials from the Karimnagar ACB unit executed a well-planned operation and caught Satish Kumar while he was accepting the bribe at his residence.



Revanth Reddy met Nitin Gadkari

Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy is fully occupied during his visit to Delhi. It is noteworthy that this is his second visit to the capital within a span of just 20 days. This morning, Revanth met with Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari. He requested immediate Cabinet approval for the northern section of the Regional Ring Road and full clearances for the southern section. He also urged the Minister to grant permissions for new road links connecting the state's national highways to dry ports.

Revanth is also scheduled to meet Union Minister for Civil Aviation Rammohan Naidu to discuss matters concerning three airports in Telangana. Additionally, the Chief Minister will meet with Union Minister for Urban Development Manohar Lal Khattar.

End to the long wait for Warangal Airport... Centre gives a key assurance!

The Centre has made a key announcement regarding the construction of the Warangal-Mamnoon Airport. Union Minister for Civil Aviation Rammohan Naidu announced that the tender process would commence in another three to four weeks. He stated that the airport would be completed by June 2, 2028. This assurance was given during a meeting with Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy in Delhi.

Rammohan Naidu mentioned that the development of airports in the state was discussed extensively during the meeting. He noted that the state government had handed over 253 acres of land—a record extent—to the Airports Authority for the Mamnoon Airport project. He expressed special gratitude to Chief Minister Revanth Reddy for this initiative. He affirmed that the work would be completed expeditiously through coordination between the Centre and the State. He also expressed his happiness at being able to facilitate the development of airports for Telangana during his tenure.

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nion Minister Bandi Sanjay lashed out at the Congress government, accusing it of brazenly trying to convince the public—despite the whole world watching—that the lake encroachment by Owaisi's college does not

exist. He questioned why the same zeal shown in demolishing the homes of the poor was not being displayed regarding these massive encroachments that are glaringly obvious to everyone. He taunted the Revanth Reddy government, asking if they truly suffered from vision problems or if the political alliance with the MIM was causing a lack of resolve to act.

He criticized the government for preaching equality before the law on paper while practicing a double standard—applying one set of rules for the poor and another for MIM leaders close to the ruling party. He advised against the practice of selectively targeting those they dislike while sparing their favorites. He demanded that the government abandon this dual approach regarding the protection of lakes.



Prashant Kishor, founder of the Jan Suraj Party and a candidate in the Bankipur by-election in Bihar, has disclosed details of his assets in his election affidavit. He stated that the total value of his assets exceeds ₹96 crore, comprising movable assets worth ₹22.19 crore and immovable assets worth ₹73.87 crore. The affidavit also revealed that his wife, Jabnavi Das, holds movable assets worth ₹89.51 crore and immovable assets worth ₹12.42 crore.

Before filing his nomination, Prashant Kishor performed special prayers at the Baba Haribarnath Temple in Sonapur. Subsequently, he proceeded to the Collectorate in a massive rally alongside party leaders and workers to file his nomination. He remarked that this was not merely a nomination filing but a struggle for political change aimed at keeping leaders with criminal backgrounds away from power.

Prashant Kishor also disclosed details regarding the cases registered against him in the affidavit. He stated that a total of eight cases have been filed against him, involving allegations such as defamation, obstruction of public servants in the discharge of their duties, and fraud. However, he noted that formal charges have not been framed in any of these cases so far. He also disclosed an outstanding bank loan of ₹5.77 crore.

Prashant Kishor owns two flats in Ghaziabad and holds a 50% share in two other flats. He also possesses properties in Patna's Patliputra Colony, Delhi's Vasant Vihar, Buxar, and his native village. His wife owns two flats in Gurgaon, a one-third share in a bungalow, and another property in Noida. The affidavit states that Prashant Kishor is the owner of Veda Venture Private Limited, a company that donated ₹85 crore to Jan Suraj in 2024-25.
